For Graduating High School Seniors

The Oklahoma Forest Heritage Center was established in 1976 for the purpose of supporting and promoting Oklahoma's forestry community. The Forest Heritage Center's goal is to provide quality educational opportunities and experiences in the benefits of sound forest practice with respect to the production of forest products; wildlife enhancement; recreational enhancement; and the environmental benefits of forest. The Forest Heritage Center provides quality learning experiences in these areas through collaboration with trusted members of Oklahoma's forestry community and its stakeholders.

In a continuing effort to support the professional development of future foresters for Oklahoma, the Forest Heritage Center sponsors a \$500 scholarship to a graduating high school senior. The applicant must be a graduate from an Oklahoma high school and provide proof of enrollment in a college level forestry or similar program in one of Oklahoma's institutes for higher education.

## Scholarship Application Requirements and Necessary Documentation:

- Proof of enrollment in a forestry program in one of Oklahoma's institutions for higher education. The enrollment must be for the fall semester of the current calendar year.
- The student must provide proof of their current grade point average.
- A brief summary of extracurricular activities in/or related to forestry.
- The student must submit an original essay titled: The Impact and Future Potential of Oklahoma's Forestland. (No minimum length)
- Two letters of reference.

## Scholarship Application Submission

- Applications will be available on the Forest Heritage Center Facebook page, and by email request.
  - The application packet may be returned via mail, electronically via email, or hand delivered to the front desk of the Forest Heritage Center located in Beavers Bend State Park; marked C/O FHC Board.
  - A deposit of the \$500 award payment will be made in the awardee's bursars account. The deposit will be made upon proof of enrollment in the fall semester, provided by applicant.
  - The FHC Board of Directors will select the recipient of the scholarship based on standardized point-based grading scale. Scores will be based on completeness of the application packet and ability to follow instructions, the quantity and quality of forestry based extracurricular activities performed, and the quality and thoughtfulness given to the essay submitted.
  - The scholarship recipient will be honored at the annual at the FHC Forestry Luncheon in September of the current year.
