**Paper making is one of the nation's oldest industries, with a history spanning over 300 years. After World War I, forests were greatly depleted due to earlier harvesting methods, leaving only small amounts of forested land.**

**During World War II, the demand for forest products increased significantly to support the war efforts.**

**The Industrial Revolution introduced many new wood products, including pulpwood. Pulpwood refers to timber that is harvested specifically for making paper and other wood pulp-based products.**

**Notice the imitation vanilla flavoring on display, which is derived from wood pulp.**
